## **Community Healthcare Service Award**

Each year Dakota Hospital Foundation recognizes a community member with the Community Health Service award. This year's Community Health Service award was presented to Timothy Tracy, Senior Director at Sanford Vermillion. The Community Health Service Award recognizes outstanding contributions of time, talent and resources benefiting the health of the community. We are pleased to present this award every year to someone in the community who we feel encompasses these values.

Tim Tracy is the son of Gerald E. and Virginia Tracy (both deceased). Tim is one of eight children, having grown up in Watertown, SD, and graduating from Watertown High School. After High School, Tim enlisted in the United States Air Force from 1974 – 1976 and in the Air National Guard from 1976 – 1982. Tim attended the University of South Dakota from 1976 – 1981. During his time at USD, Tim met Kathy, the love of his life, and they were married in the spring of 1977. Kathy and Tim's family grew by three during his college career, and this family of five celebrated the awarding of his Bachelor's Degree in Administration in 1981. Tim was awarded his Masters Degree in Administration from Central Michigan University in 2004.

Tim has served as a health care administrator in South Dakota and North Dakota since 1983. He has been the Chief Executive Officer of Sanford Vermillion Medical Center since April 2004. During Tim's tenure in health care, he has assisted in the development of model rural health care centers in Vermillion, South Dakota, Cando, North Dakota and Gettysburg, South Dakota.

Tim is an ordained Deacon for the Catholic Diocese of Eastern South Dakota, currently serving at St. Agnes Parish & School in Vermillion while assisting with several Diocesan-wide assignments.

Tim currently serves as a Delegate to the American Hospital Association for the South Dakota Association of Healthcare Organizations, is past chair of SDAHO Board of Directors, and has served on various committees. He was a Board Member and Chair of the South Dakota Healthcare Executive Group. Tim served as the North Dakota Healthcare Association chair from 2001 - 2003, where he has also served as vice-chair, secretary/treasurer, director at large, and committee member. He was also secretary of the North Dakota Board of Examiners for Nursing Home Administrators, a member of the North Dakota Long Term Care Association, and a member of the American College of Healthcare Executives.

Tim has been active in community service organizations, including the American Legion and Economic Development organizations in every community. Locally he has served on the Main Street Center Board, the Vermillion Area Dance Organization (VADO) Board, the Vermillion Chamber and Development Company Board and various committees at St. Agnes. He was honored by the Dakota Conference on Rural Health with its Outstanding Rural Health Professional award in 1997, and in 2001, by the American Hospital Association with the Shirley Ann Munroe Leadership Development Award.

When asked of his most rewarding activities in Vermillion, Tim would say:

- Bringing Sanford Vermillion into a new age through the efforts of DHF – the Medical Staff and the Leadership,
- leading the committee which raised the needed funds to remodel and add-on to St. Agnes School,
- serving as a Deacon at St. Agnes Church,
- helping to secure DHF and community funds for the Main Street Center updates,
- building and securing of funds for the VADO dance studio,
- helping to establish DHF grant programs, employee programs and scholarships,
- and the development of Sanford Vermillion Arts in Healthcare program.

Tim takes pride in his faith and family, proud to be blessed with three children, their spouses, and their nine grandchildren. Tim will miss his church family, his work family, and Vermillion but takes many fond memories into retirement. He will be back from time to time. GO YOTES!!!
