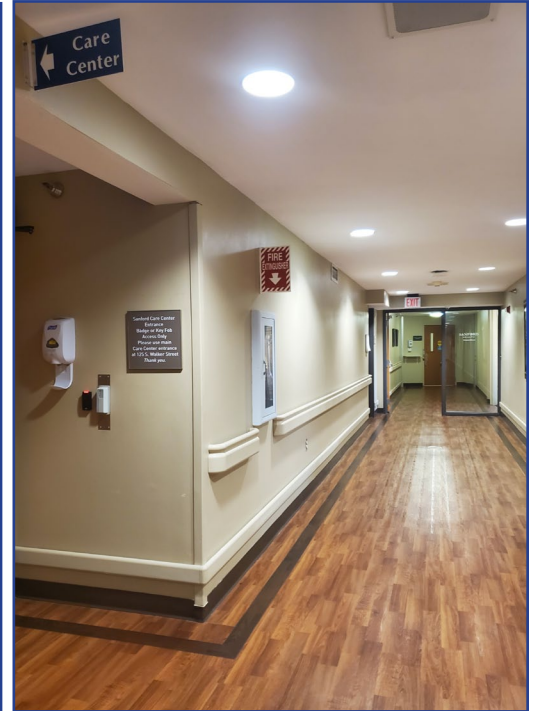
2024 Employee Idea Challenge Project Updates

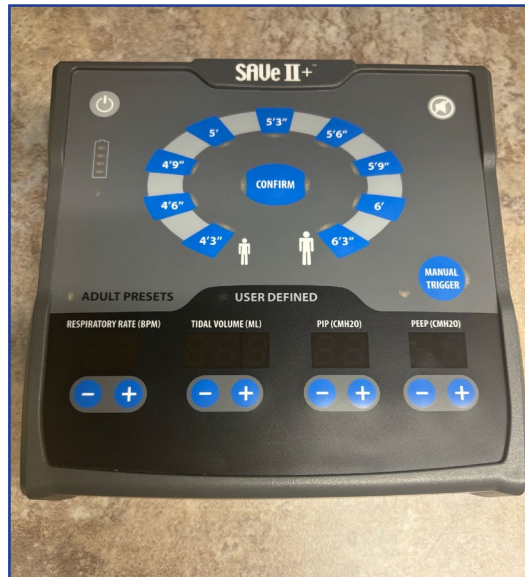

This summer, the Plant Operations team completed that installation for our frequent passersby!

Great timing, dollars saved. Sanford Vermillion received grant dollars to purchase a secondary **Ventilator** as submitted by Courtney Trometer, Respiratory Therapy.

The **Eva Support Walker** is being used quite often in the rehabilitation department. Gail Buhler, Physical Therapist, submitted this project inspired by a hopeful patient who said, "all I want to do is walk again, that means everything to me".

Dakota Hospital Foundation and Sanford Vermillion Medical Center Support USDs Healthcare Careers Summer Camp 2024

The 18th Annual Healthcare Careers Summer Camp took place at the University of South Dakota June 9-14, 2024. A total of 32 HCSC participants and three camp counselors attended. Two of the camp counselors were past HCSC participants, and are now Medical Biology majors here at USD.

Closing exercises were held the morning of Friday, June 14 for the participants and their family members. Each student gave their perspective on the week's activities with much gratitude, saying they made many new friends, really enjoyed the Gross Anatomy lab and the Parry Center for Clinical Skills & Simulation, and that the camp solidified their interest in the healthcare field.

During the week, campers were introduced to a variety of health careers available to them in South Dakota. The week started with a tour of the Sanford Vermillion Medical Center's Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Cardiac Rehab, and Sanford Arts departments. In the Lee Medical building, there were presentation sessions where presenters talked of their specific programs such as Dental Hygiene, Nursing, Physical Therapy, Med Lab Sciences, Health Administration, they toured BBS research labs and had a visit from the SD Army National Guard. Each session included a hands-on activity that the students really enjoyed. We, again, incorporated a Mini Med School Camp led by current medical students from the CO2027. They offered sessions on Patient-Based Learning, gowning/

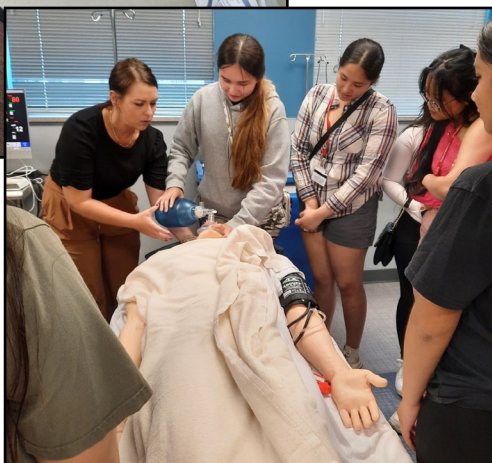
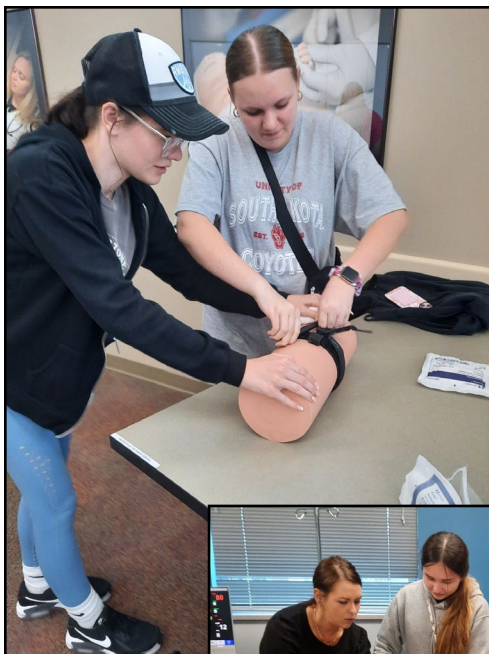


gloving, suture/knot tying, casting/splinting with Dr. Roy Mortensen, ultrasound, physical exam skills, and a Q&A session with the medical students. Camp highlights included touring the SSOM Gross Anatomy Lab, the Parry Center for Clinical Skills & Simulation, and USD Nursing simulation lab.

All participants successfully completed and received certificates for the Stop the Bleed course and the 2024 Healthcare Careers Summer Camp.

Financial and in-kind support for the 2024 camp was provided by Delta Dental of South Dakota Foundation, Dakota Hospital Foundation, Sanford Vermillion Medical Center, Sanford School of Medicine, Sanford Health, USD School of Health Sciences, West River Area Health Education Center (WRAHEC), and the South Dakota Department of Social Services. 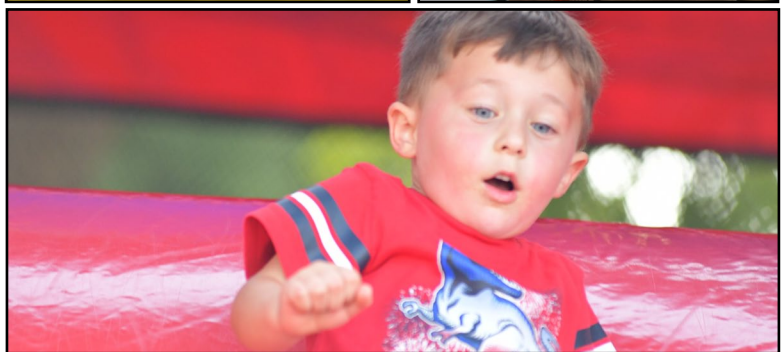
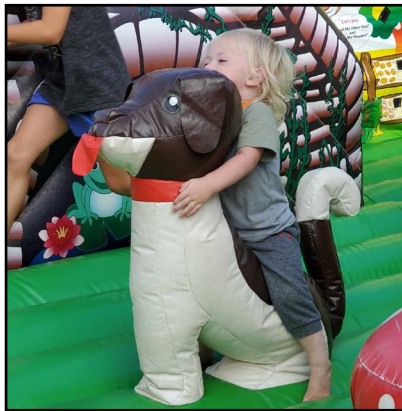
Community Celebration

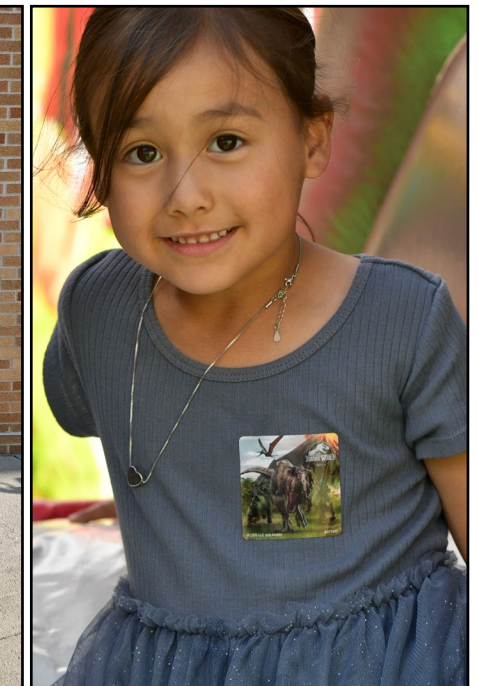
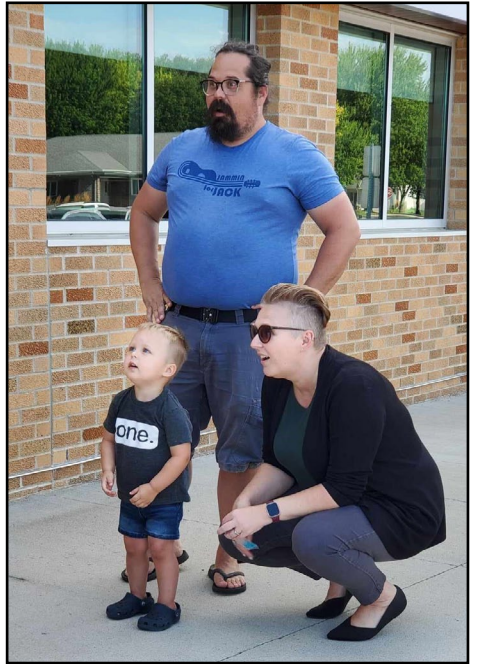
